Pitkin/Barbey, Sutter/Barbey.

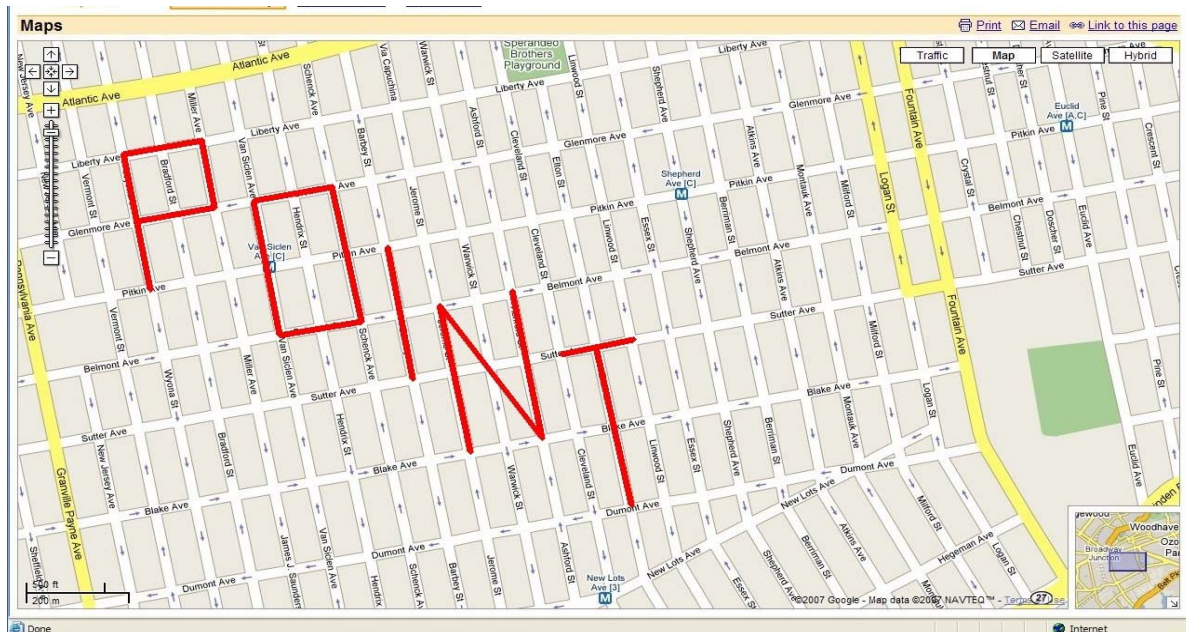
Blake/Jerome, Belmont/Jerome, Blake/Ashford, Belmont/Ashford.
