As part of the Hurricane Sandy Recovery process, New York City implemented the NYC Build It Back program. The program provided owners whose homes were demolished or destroyed as a result of damage caused by Hurricane Sandy the construction funds necessary to help them rebuild to what they had before Sandy.

The survey services included establishing horizontal and vertical control, performing existing building locations, first floor elevations, topographic surveys, and location of existing utilities including rim and invert elevations, deed research and providing flood certifications.
